



Modern travel gets a first-class upgrade with Ascent, a modular seating system by Brad Ascalon. Ash veneer treated to a clear stain or transparent lacquer clads the monolithic MDF-and-plywood base, while curvy ergonomic seats bring a touch of whimsy. The cold foamcushioning can be covered in custom textiles; Ascalon suggests calming pastels. The three-seat version spans 80 inches; the fourseater, 105. Both are 32⊠inches high. Ascent incorporates power and USB charging and offers surfaces for drinks, books, laptops, or other belongings—perfect for hospitality and transportation settings, mitab.se. circle 291 >
