

Design-minded denizens should shop Hello World's uptown location (257 S. 20th St., 215-545-5207; shophelloworld.com) to find gifts, accessories and home décor. We especially like the Melie Bianco vegan handbags-the line's cruelty-free faux leather looks like the real thing. Over at Casa Papel (804 N. Second St., 267-761-9149; casapapel.com) in Northern Liberties, the specialty is custom papercraft and design. Head here to browse a pretty selection of cards and stationery, or have a coffee-table book or photo album bound. If saving the planet is on your mind, stop by the newest outpost of the Big Green Earth Store (934 South St., 267-909-8661, biggreenearthstore.com), which stocks tons of eco-friendly home products, including electronics. (Our favorite: computer cases equipped with solar panels that can gather enough energy to charge a laptop.) For inspired décor, be sure to visit Ligne Roset (4131 Main St., Manayunk, 215-487-2800; ligne-roset-usa.com). The Spindle table, a fabulous modern piece created by local designer Brad Ascalon, features a black-lacquered wooden spindle sandwiched between two sheets of clear curved glass. Thanks to a unique partnership, Ascalon, a Cherry Hill native, is one of only two American designers fortunate enough to be able to collaborate with the French company.



Y'S BEST

Now is the perfect time to plant a new flower box-or, better yet, have local garden experts create one for you. Poppy Flower Shop (616 S. Sixth St., 215-574-1221; poppyflowershop.com) offers a wide variety of flowers and herbs to choose from, including cold-weather species like kale and sedum. At City Planter (814 N. Fourth St., 215-627-6169; cityplanter.com), botanical experts work with you to select a flower box full of plants; about a week later they'll deliver the finished product to any Center City address. For the definitive custom window box, call up the pros at Philadelphia Windowbox Company (610-310-1973; philadelphiawindowboxcompany.com). They'll start with a wooden box and then paint, stain and add molding or paneling to it so that the new addition matches the exterior of your home. And don't worry about frost: During the winter months, staff will refresh your box with evergreens and other hardy cold-weather plants.
